Proposed topics:

- The application of TLM/SEM on Turkish flora focussing especially on Fagaceae and tricolporate pollen. Comparison with palynomorph record of Central Europe and Paratethys realm.
- Modern oaks in the Caucasus and their pollen morphology
- Short-term climate and vegetation dynamics in the Neogene of Western Anatolia. Potential of local strata for possible comparisons with coeval European records.
- Taxodioids of the Anatolian Miocene peat forming vegetation, evidence from macro- and micro floral records.
- Openning of landscapes in Turkey and possible comparison with European records.
- Neogene lacustrine systems in Western Anatolia.
- Updates of Palaeoflora database: Morphotaxa and their NLRs included in the volumes of the Atlas of Pollen and Spores of the Polish Neogene (L. Stuchlik, ed.)

Additional suggestions, ideas on topics to be discussed in the scope of the workshop are highly welcome.

Unfortunately, we do not have at our Faculty any reference pollen collection. Please, bring with you slides you would like to discuss with your colleagues.

There is no strict time limit for your presentations, because we would like to have fruitfull working atmosphere without too many regulations during our meeting.
